Southampton CTC is the local CTC group for the area covering Southampton, Romsey, Eastleigh, Chandlers Ford and Waterside and we regularly welcome riders from outside this area. We offer a range of cycle rides and also organise special events throughout the year. We also campaign locally for better cycle facilities.



About our rides

Our rides range from short, easy rides suitable for novice cyclists to more challenging rides that are longer and faster.

We run regular Saturday and Sunday rides, occasional weekday and evening rides in the summer and Wednesday social night in the clubroom.

Most rides are on-road but we occasionally venture off-road, especially in the drier summer months.

Our Saturday rides are generally gentle-paced and Sunday rides moderate or faster/longer. Half-day rides usually include a café stop and day rides both a café and pub-lunch stop, occasionally afternoon tea as well.
